

#### Children's Lateness

### School Dinner Money

If your child is in KS2 please ensure that you purchase dinner tickets in advance if you would like your child to have a school dinner provided.

Havering Catering Services will currently provide a dinner without a ticket but we write to advise that if a debt amounts to £10.00\* or more then a school dinner will not be provided and you will need to issue a packed lunch from home. Failure to clear a debt may result in Havering Catering Services passing this onto their debt collection department. If a child leaves any school within Havering with a debt this will be transferred onto their next school.

There are now three ways in which to pay this debt and purchase tickets in advance for future use.

- Dinner tickets can be purchased on Monday mornings (from 8.30am) directly from cook in the dining room\*\*
