If you child is participating in the Year 6 activity week in May we kindly ask that you send your contribution into school as soon as possible. Thank You.

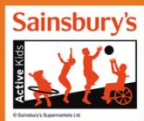
Scholastics Book Fair

Owed Dinner Money

If you owe any school dinner money to Havering Catering Services please arrange payment immediately.

With immediate effect you will only be able to owe for one dinner/drink (£2.20 or £2.50) before you will have to provide a packed lunch from home.

As you are aware the new sQuid payment system will soon be introduced and you must be in credit to enable your child to receive a school dinner. Registration codes along with further information will be issued soon.

Any monies owed when sQuid goes live will be transferred to your account.

Havering Catering Services & sQuid Online - KS1 & KS2

Introducing sQuid online payment for school dinner tickets & drinks

Havering Catering Services are rolling out a cashless payment system called sQuid across all schools within Havering for the purchase of dinner tickets and drinks. sQuid will be launched at Crowlands after the Easter holiday. Once sQuid is launched this will be the only way to purchase a dinner ticket/drinks for your child. Havering Catering Services will no longer be selling tickets online, by telephone or via the school.

You will soon be sent a letter with your child's sQuid registration details

This will be a 16 digit registration number and 3 digit security code that you should register on the sQuid website. If you have more than one child at the school, they will each be issued with their own registration number. Simply follow the instructions set out in the letter to create your online sQuid account and register your child.

Once you have created a sQuid account for your child, you will also be able to manage their account online at any time to:

- Top up their account from your bank account, credit or debit card
- Enable Auto top up so that they never run out of funds
- Check their account balance
- View their transactions

It is very important that you sign up for this service as you will be unable to purchase dinner tickets/drinks through any other method. Your account must be in credit to enable your child to receive a school dinner.
