### Breakfast Club

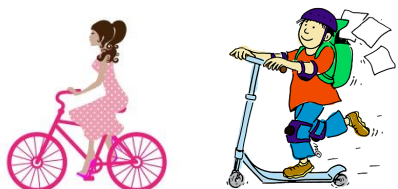
