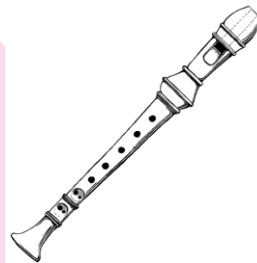

Children's Lateness

We have noticed increasing numbers of late arrivals since the Autumn Term. This causes disruption to your child's education and to children already settled and learning in class. Doors open at 8.40am and close at 8.50am. Any children arriving after this time will be registered as late. Children who are consistently late for school will be passed onto the Educational Welfare Officer.



Early Arrivals

We have noticed that some children are arriving at school very early. Please be reminded that children will not be permitted onto the school site before 8.20am.



School Dinner Money

If your child is in KS2 please ensure that you purchase dinner tickets in advance if you would like your child to have a school dinner provided.

Havering Catering Services will currently provide a dinner without a ticket but we write to advise that if a debt amounts to £10.00* or more then a school dinner will not be provided and you will need to issue a packed lunch from home. Failure to clear a debt may result in Havering Catering Services passing this onto their debt collection department. If a child leaves any school within Havering with a debt this will be transferred onto their next school.

There are now three ways in which to pay this debt and purchase tickets in advance for future use.
