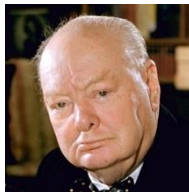

The Churchill house are this week's team winners. They will receive extra playtime. Well done!



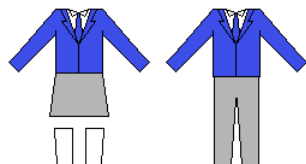
Year 6 Residential
