sQuid

If you have not registered for sQuid cashless dinner payment system please do so as soon as possible by using your unique registration code. You must still register if you are entitled to universal or free school meals.

Once you have created a sQuid account for your child, you will also be able to manage their account online at any time to:

- Top up their account from your bank account, credit or debit card
- Enable Auto top up so that they never run out of funds
- Check their account balance
- View their transactions

Children not registered must be provided with packed lunch from home. If registered but there are insufficient funds on your account your child will be unable to order a dinner and will be provided with, for one day only, a sandwich, piece of fruit and water at a cost of £2.20 to you.
