If you have not registered for sQuid cashless dinner payment system please do so as soon as possible by using your unique registration code that can be obtained from the main school office. You must also register if you are entitled to universal or free school meals.

Children not registered must be provided with a packed lunch from home. If registered but there are insufficient funds on your account your child will be unable to order a dinner and will be provided with, for one day only, a sandwich, piece of fruit and water at a cost of £2.20 to you.
