Dear Parents/Carers,

Late collection of children at the end of the school day

We have been seeing an increasing number of occasions where children are being collected late at the end of the school day. We are aware that there are frequently valid reasons or emergencies where the parents/carers have been delayed and when the school is informed in advance of this.

However, some parents/carers appear to be collecting their children late on a regular basis with no prior contact or reason.

The impact on a child not being collected on time can lead to unnecessary anxiety and distress. It also impacts on staff who need to supervise them.

With effect from Monday 30th October 2017 a charge of £1.00 for every 15 minutes late collection per child, after 3.30pm, will be introduced.

This charge will need to be paid immediately upon collection or within the same school week.

If children remain uncollected by 4.00pm, safeguarding processes will be started and a referral will be made to social services and to the police.
